Fisheries Biologist Summary: Oversees fisheries staff including hatchery staff, manages the tribal fish hatchery, collects field data throughout the watershed, analyses data and provides various monthly reports to the Departmental Director. Negotiates species harvests with the Washington State Department of Fish and Wildlife. Administers the Tribe's Upper Chehalis Restoration and Fisheries Programs. Assists Director in obtaining funding grants. Performs biological assessments when needed. Obtains necessary hydraulic permits on behalf of the Tribe. Publically represents the Tribe at various stakeholders meetings throughout the basin. Assists the Departmental Director in annual budgeting for fisheries program. **Education:** Bachelor of Science in Biology or Fisheries Science. **Experience:** Minimum six years experience directly related to the position duties and responsibilities.
