Position Description: Assist the NWIFC-SSHIAP program in the transformation of fish distribution and *AquaScape* datasets from its existing hydrography to the National Hydrography Dataset (NHD). Assist in the development of a data framework for collecting, compiling and/or editing tribal information related to fish distribution and stream habitat segments for the Washington State Water Resource Inventory Areas (WRIAs) within the Puget Sound and Pacific Coast regions.

Qualifications: Bachelor's degree in GIS, Natural Resources or related field and one year of pertinent work experience. Applicants working towards Bachelor's degree will be considered depending on work experience. Combined background in fish habitat biology and ArcGIS data analysis and management is required. Specific background in fish distribution and stream data analysis using Linear Referencing methods is desired. Ability to analyze and compile technical information and communicate results to supervisor. Ability to work independently under minimal supervision and cooperatively in a team.
